Issue Setup (Issue Management)

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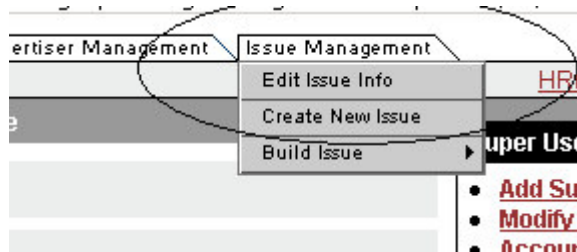

There are main steps to issue setup:

1. Create a new issue
2. Make identical issue
3. Add existing products to this issue
4. Remove Products from this issue
5. Issue Checking Report
6. Manage RS Numbers (if applicable)

**It is recommended to do steps 2-5 rather than create a new issue from scratch. The user can create an identical issue (from an old one) and adjust the issue as needed

Within "other related tasks", the add/remove existing products(s) from this issue" **will be removed** (it was added back due to client concern of the page changing. Using this link will cause a slowdown and possible timeout error)

To increase efficiency within the issue setup, the workflow can be done as follows (following the steps above):

Step 1: Create a new issue

By filling in the required info, create the new issue (below):

****By pulling a previous issue (i.e. May 06) and comparing it to the new issue (June 06), the user can identify which ads are new/changed, etc.**

Most of the ads within the issue will be the same but with different RS numbers and page numbers (these can be changed later)

Even if only 30% of the book is the same (in terms of ads as the previous issue), this will save time in setting up each individual ad for a larger book

Step 2: Make "issue" identical to another issue

The user can make the new issue (June 06) the same as the May 06 issue (see below):

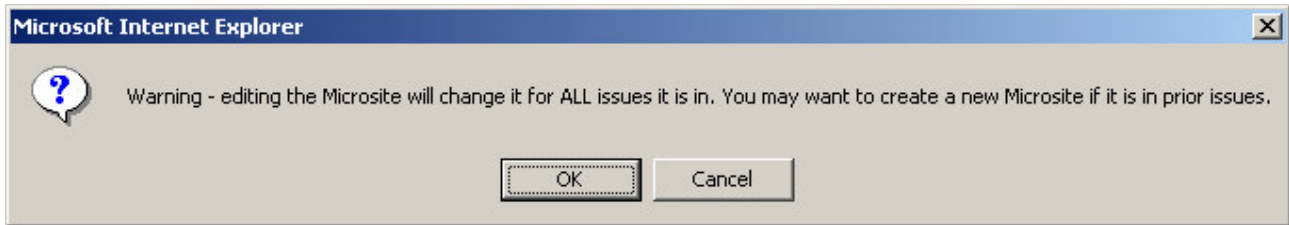

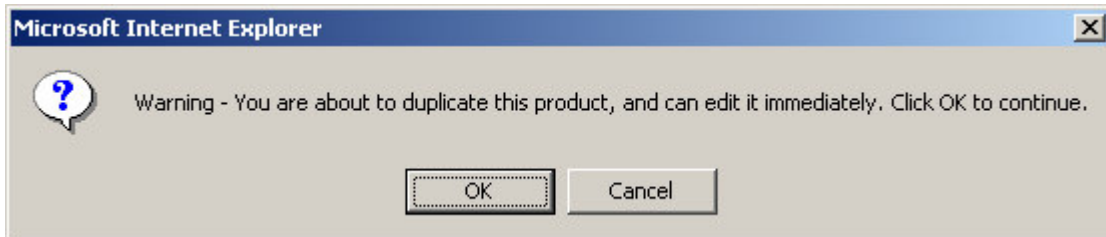

**For books with a large number of listings, it is recommended to do issue setup in smaller batches (to reduce the load on the server)
